PROGRAM OUTLINE AND STRUCTURE



BRG has partnered with local high schools and organizations to identify high-potential students. Requirements include at least a 3.0 GPA (on a 4.0 scale), consistent attendance, and taking the most rigorous course load available.



The program is open to students in ninth through twelfth grades but is intended to start at the ninth-grade level and follow the student throughout high school.



The program includes a weeklong summer session that will consist of a welcome event, four consecutive days on site, and various class offerings. The program will offer educational sessions, skill-building sessions, networking opportunities, and electives. Students also will be invited to participate in quarterly events, including college admission panels, local day trips, and informational sessions with our experts.



Instructors for the various sessions offered are BRG professionals participating on a volunteer basis.



BRG professionals will provide mentorship opportunities to students to provide them with assistance navigating high school, the college application process, and other aspects of early-stage professional development.



BRG's Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) team will cover transportation and meal costs.



Participating BRG offices will include Washington, DC, Los Angeles, New York, and Boston.
